Dear Parents,

This letter is to inform you that Homework Club for Grades 3/4; Grades 5/6 and Grades 7/8 is available to your child after school from 2:45 – 3:45 PM. The Grades 3 and 4 Homework Club will meet in the Health Room, #206, on Tuesdays and Thursdays; the Grades 5 and 6 club will meet in room #250 most Mondays, every Tuesday and Thursday; and the Grades 7 and 8 club will meet in Room # 225 Monday - Thursday. We believe that this is an excellent opportunity for your child to get some homework completed before leaving school as well as to receive support or clarification with any aspect of homework in which he/she may be having difficulty.

The staff members running the Homework Club are knowledgeable about the content being taught in the classes as well as the teacher's expectations for homework assignments.

We strongly encourage your support in having your son/daughter attend on a regular basis if he/she is having a difficult time getting homework completed or is confused about a particular subject or assignment. If your child is productive and efficient with the time spent during Homework Club, he/she could leave at 3:45 PM with much of the homework completed.

Please read the Rules of the Homework Club below. Since we plan to create a working environment for all students, appropriate behavior is very important. If a student's behavior is disruptive during this time, he/she will be asked to leave, and a call/message will be made to the home. The student may return to Homework Club after one week. We would appreciate it very much if you would review these expectations with your child.

THE RULES OF THE HOMEWORK CLUB

Homework Club is a time for students to work on homework and receive assistance if needed. Students make a commitment to stay after school for an hour to work on their homework; therefore, it is very important that all students are respectful of each other's time and homework environment.

1. The Homework Club needs to be a quiet space where students can concentrate and complete schoolwork. You can certainly ask for and receive help but be thoughtful of others. All students may not be working on the same question or subject, so please keep your voices low.
2. You are expected to be working diligently on homework while you are at the Homework Club.
3. You must check in with your Homework Club teacher by 2:45 PM so that she/he knows who is attending. If you need to see another teacher before coming to the Homework Club, **FIRST** check in with the Homework Club teacher and let her know where you are going. After 2:45, no one will be admitted into the Homework Club without a note from a teacher.
4. You may not leave the building before Homework Club. A snack will be provided.
5. Please have a book to read when and if your other homework is completed
6. Once you sign in for Homework Club, you are making the commitment to stay until 3:45 PM. If you must leave earlier than 3:45 PM, you will need to get a note from a parent/guardian stating the time you need to leave. Homework Club is officially over at 3:45 PM.
7. All snacks must be cleared and chairs should be put away according to teacher directions. The room should be left in good order.
8. We hope that your time at the Homework Club is beneficial to you. Study hard, get all your work completed, and watch your grades improve!!
